Killoqua's living units include both smaller cabins with 9 beds each, as well as larger structures with 25-30 beds per building. Common spaces and meeting rooms are also available. These pages show a sampling of units—please contact us to determine which spaces will best serve your group's needs.

Tapala: A circle of 5 cabins around a fire ring. Each cabin has 9 beds, electric heat, shower, toilet and sinks.

Whulje: A circle of 4 cabins around a fire ring. Whulje cabins are identical to Tapala cabins.





## Hill House:

- common room as seen below, not pictured: a small kitchenette along one wall of common room. This includes a refrigerator, stove, microwave, sink, and some cupboard space.
- 2 restrooms with showers, and 4 bedrooms.
- sleeps up to 20 people.
- Electric heat throughout, plus a wood stove.







## CIT:

- Sleeps 12 people, and is heated by wood stove.
- The left wing of the building is another sleeping area, open seasonally because it is not heated.
- The right wing of the building holds the restrooms, and a small kitchenette which includes a sink, stove, and refrigerator.





## KwaLaDi

- Common area pictured at left. Not shown is kitchenette including sink, stove, refrigerator.
- Building available for rental as a whole, or just upstairs portion. Upstairs sleeps 16, downstairs 14.
- There are 2 restrooms upstairs and 1 downstairs.
- Electric heat as well as wood stoves.
