Created in the 1950's, The WoHeLo Award represents the highest achievement for young people in Camp Fire. This award is an intensive, individualized project that is designed by the youth. The youth plan and work on the project as an individual, though many of the activities will involve working with, leading and coordinating groups of people in the areas of their advocates.

Isabella is the daughter of Robert and Catrin Riggs. She is a 2018 graduate from Meadowdale High School. Bella has been in Camp Fire for 12 years.

Bella spent several years working on her WoHeLo project in three advocacy areas: Camp Fire Club Aide, JAM (Journey Art Ministry), and founded and developed the Speech Club at Meadowdale High School.

She has been active with Meadowdale Speech Club, a nursery assistant at church, volunteering with JAM middle school girls art club, and singing with the Seattle Children's Chorus.
