Starfish and Tornados

Having kids recognize and label their emotions is a

great start to social / emotional health. In Camp Fire, kids learn to Thrive. We use Thrive{ology} to help kids become the best version of themselves. Ask your kids to think about what it feels like to be a calm Starfish and a whirling Tornado. Have them identify where their feelings are on the thermometer. Ask them to think about a time that they felt like a tornado and think about how hard it was to concentrate.

- Take a Breath
- Do breathing exercises—count to 10
- Turn up the music and dance
- Exercise or be active
- Take a mental vacation—use imagery
- Hug a pillow or stuffed animal

As our kids are finishing up their school year, there could be times when they feel like a tornado. Learning to identify their emotions and having strategies to calm down are essential skills so that our kids can thrive.
