- Adjust Strategies – reflect on what works and what does not
- Seek Help - make it ok to ask for and receive help

Absolutely Incredible Kid Day March 18, 2021

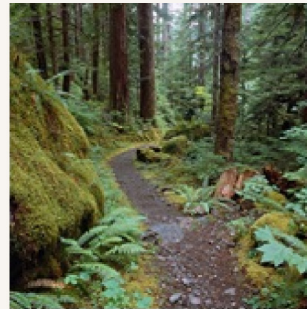
