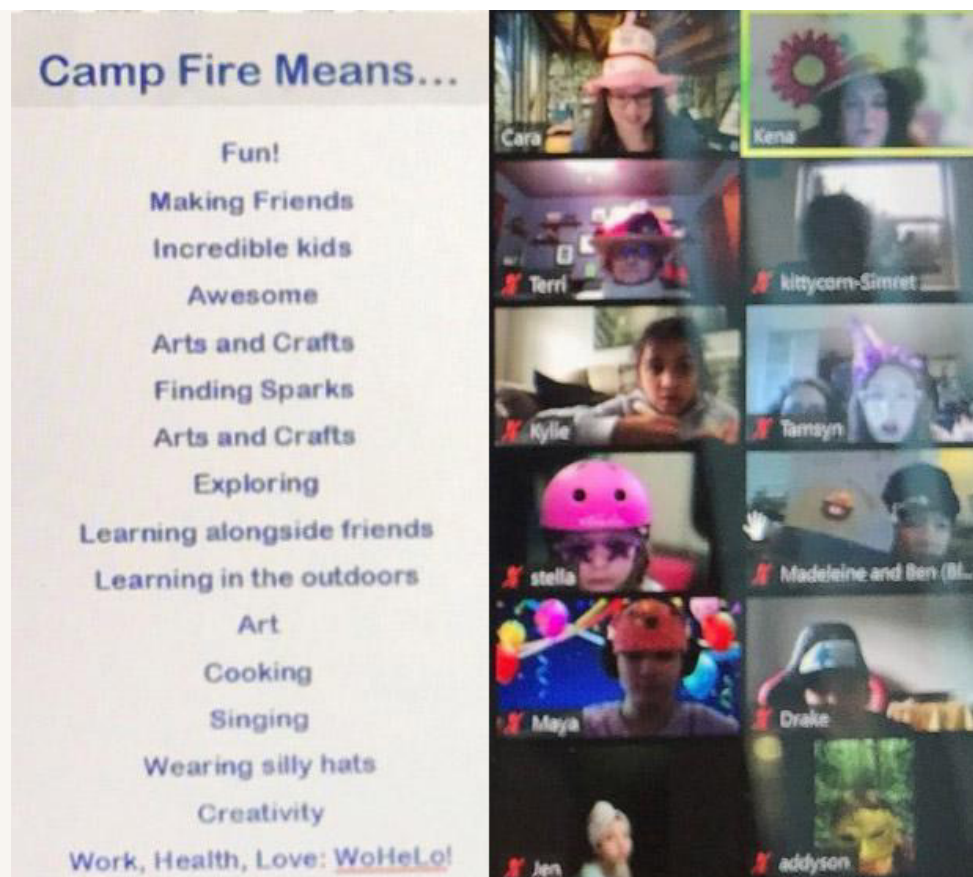


Giveaway Auction **Extravaganza!** **June 3, 5:30pm** **Everett Community College** **Fitness Center**
