#### National Art Experience LIGHT

What is Light? Light is a form of electromagnetic radiation that is visible to the human eye. It is also essential to art.

Camp Fire is challenging young people to think about the role that light plays in their lives. Do they live in an area where there is very little light, especially in certain seasons? Do they live where the light is bright, and where the light affects temperature, flora, and fauna? How does sunlight make you feel compared to a rainy or cloudy day? Do you get excited when you see a rainbow?

The purpose of this year's National Art Experience is for young people to think about the significance of light in their lives, and to translate these ideas into art. We encourage youth to complete 4 out of the 10 projects over several months as part of the Art Experience.

- 1. Shadows: Shadow Tracing and Miniature Shadow Puppets
- 2. Sun Prints
- 3. Rainbows: Light an indoor rainbow and Catch an Outdoor Rainbow
- 4. Oil & Paper Lanterns
- 5. Light in the Landscape
- 6. Constellations: Make Your Own and Flashlight Constellations
- 7. Art in the Moonlight
- 8. Pinhole Camera
- 9. Still Life by Candlelight
- 10. Stained Glass



This fun event brings families together to celebrate the spirit of gratitude. Join us on November 16th - 17th.


We will play games, do fun camp activities, and make creative crafts. We will also sit down to a Thanksgiving meal together!
